**Day 1: Buenos Aires**

Arrival at Buenos Aires International Airport EZE (Ezeiza). Meet with your **ALCHEMY DMC Argentina** English speaking guide, after customs, at the arrival hall of the airport.

The name, Buenos Aires, literally means "good airs" in Spanish. It is one of the largest cities in Latin America, with a wide range of cultural offers and stunning sights. Being the capital of the country makes it the starting point for most of the Argentinean Experiences. Let yourself be seduced by its busy and beautiful streets full of Tango aromas and football passion, a unique mixture that turns your stay into an exceptional urban adventure.

**Buenos Aires City Tour**

Duration: 4 hours + 2 hours lunch



This tour includes the city's main attractions, covering the City center and Plaza de Mayo square, San Telmo, La Boca, Puerto Madero, Retiro, Recoleta and Palermo areas. The order of the tour may vary depending on the day's logistics and your pickup and drop-off spot. Take the famous 9 de Julio Avenue, where our Teatro Colon Opera House and the iconic Obelisk are located to hop off the vehicle and visit our foundational area- Plaza de Mayo Square. This square is not only important for its role in our history, but it is nowadays the heartbeat of the city, being our political and economic epicenter. Take a peek on the important buildings that surround it: the Metropolitan Cathedral, the Government House- or Pink House- the Cabildo or former City Hall and the Municipality, while learning about their history and our city's origins.

Head South, following the paths of our immigrants, along narrow streets and colonial style houses, and discover San Telmo, cradle of Tango, one of our present passions and also famous for its Flea Market on Sundays. Further to the South is La Boca area with the Caminito pedestrian street- an area of artists and an important center of attraction and an open-air museum in its full expression. It is here where the Club Atletico Boca Juniors` stadium is located – where you will feel the greatest exponent of another Argentina's Passion: Football.

Nearby, the famous Puerto Madero, which was long time ago an English style port, is nowadays one of the most modern and exclusive areas in town, with 5 star-hotels modern company buildings and residences and a gastronomic pole. Here you will take a look to the famous Calatrava "Puente de la Mujer" bridge. As you cross Retiro area to the North, Buenos Aires` landscape changes again, as this is a city of contrasts. Recoleta looks like a Petit Paris, with its French style buildings and residences, its green areas and the ample avenues and high-end shops. A visit to the unique Recoleta Cemetery is almost mandatory- as it is an open-air museum, filled with stories, art, architecture and urban legends. Many important and famous Argentines rest here, including the very well-known Evita Duarte de Perón.

Nearby, a 20-meter-tall metal flower known as Floralis Genérica, a monument to all existing flowers, awaits to take part in some of your most beautiful postcards of our city. Palermo, which is the biggest neighborhood in town, is well known for its green areas, filled with trees, flowers, fountains and monuments. There are many sub- hoods – Palermo Chico with French style embassies and museum, Palermo Hollywood with restaurants and pubs and multimedia studios and Palermo Soho with ample gastronomy choices and designer shops just to mention some.

Today, Café Tortoni is perhaps the best preserved of the city's many officially recognized historic cafés, known as "Bares Notables".

Iguazu Waterfalls are located near the triple border between Argentina, Paraguay, and Brazil. They are composed of 275 cascades and fed by the Iguazu river flow. The falls are split between Brazil and Argentina, being Argentina the country with over 80% of the extension of the waterfalls. One of the most important attractions in this place is "Garganta del Diablo" or "Devil's throat" which is the biggest fall of the complex (80 meters high). No matter if you decide to explore the waterfalls on the Argentinean side or if you want to contemplate them from Brazil, you may rest assured that the experience is a mesmerizing show.

**Argentinean Side Waterfalls Full Day Tour**

**Iguazú National Park** is located in the northwest of the province of Misiones, at 11 miles from Puerto Iguazú. Its preserved ecosystem belongs to the Paraná Jungle eco region that covers almost all the provincial territory. The natural treasure being hosted are the Iguazú Waterfalls: 275 waterfalls that reach an altitude of almost 260 feet. They were declared one of the New Seven Wonders of Nature in the World and, also, Mankind Natural Heritage.

The **Lower Circuit** is composed of a trail approximately 0.8 miles (1.3 km) long that allows you to get close to some of the smaller waterfalls on the Argentinian side. Walk along the trail, which is equipped with both restrooms and snack bars, and get close to the Carlos Bozzetti Waterfall, where you can take some great photos.

The **Upper Circuit**, which is wheelchair accessible, allows you to see the top of the majestic falls on the Argentina side and enjoy a breathtaking panoramic view of the area. The view stretches from the Argentinian falls to San Martin Island and parts of the Brazilian falls. **Devil's Throat** is the largest waterfall in the region and where the largest amount of water pours through Iguassu Falls. At an impressive altitude of 350 feet (107 meters), Devil's Throat is a must-see Iguassu Falls feature. Thanks to the newly built catwalk, you can get pretty close.

Fortín Cataratas Restaurant is one of the few gastronomic options within the National Park. It offers unlimited buffet service, grill and traditional Argentine food. There is also a variety of fast foods for those who do not want to miss a minute of the Falls. It is located steps from the Visitor's Center and the central station of the Ecological Train.

### Great Adventure

Duration: 2 hours.



The **Great Adventure** is unique, and combines the whole essence of the Iguassu National Park in one ride: the jungle and the waterfalls. It is offered daily every full hour, and the departures are from our Head Office or The Visitors Center.

It starts by entering the jungle from the "Sendero Yacarutía" trail with special transportation that allows a panoramic view of the environment along with experienced guides that give a lot of explanations as well as the legend of this spectacular place.

After an 8 km truck ride, we arrive at the Puerto Macuco Base, which is 100 meters away from the Infirmary and Service Station, and 100 meters of stairs ahead is the floating platform where the second part of this ride begins.

With motor-boats, we take visitors 6 km through the Canyon of the Iguassu River, until the falls, from these total, 2 km are river rapids. After enjoying the view from the calm side of San Martin Island we sail to the "Tres Mosqueteros" waterfall, at that point, the Brazilian and Argentinean sides and the Devil's Throat can be clearly appreciated. After that, we sail along the shore of the island until we get to the most exciting part where we face the San Martin waterfall, a wonderful and unforgettable experience, for it's the largest waterfall any motor-boat can approach safely.

## **Day 4: Iguazu - Buenos Aires**

### **Brazilian Side Waterfalls Half Day Tour**

Private experience- national park tickets included



**Iguassu National Park** was created in 1939 by the Decree N° 1,035. It houses the largest remnant of Atlantic forest (semideciduous stationary) in southern **Brazil**.

The name of the Iguassu National Park refers to the Iguassu River, which in the Guaraní language means “large water”. It has 185,262.5 thousand hectares and houses an enormous biodiversity.

You'll get a close-up view of Devil's Throat, which is best seen from the Brazilian side. Watch as 14 falls drop 350 feet (107 meters) with such force that a 100-foot (30-meter) tall cloud of mist stays permanently suspended overhead. This area is famous for its rainbow, and more great photo opportunities abound!

For a close-up of the falls, walk through the park's subtropical forest to the base of **Salto Floriano**. Then take the elevator to the top of the falls, or walk out over the falls at **Salto Union**.
